

This semester, each student will be required to complete a minimum of five projects. Each project will require a Project Plan, the finished Project, and a Learning Tutorial. **ASK** about some of the equipment we have available! You might get ideas from that.

Project Plan:

You will only submit the Project Plan once, for 50 points. No revisions will be required unless individually required. Remember what is required for these plans; business writing, full responses, detailed information, and correct spelling.

Projects:

These five projects will be broken down as follows.

<u>Photography</u> - Students will take photos and manipulate said photos using Adobe Photoshop CS6. Minimum 6 finished images, including 1 selfie.

<u>Videography</u> - Students will shoot video and create 1 of the following:

Music Video

Commercial

Public Service Announcement (using personal footage)

Parody

Other ideas need prior approval

All videos must be a minimum of 3 minutes in length. Finished products must be compiled in either Adobe After Effects or Adobe Premier Pro.

Sound - Using Garageband or Audacity, you are to create an MP3 file from these options:

Music Mashup

Your own song

Digital Story

Other ideas need prior approval

All MP3s must be a minimum of 3 minutes in length.

One of the five projects must be completed in one of the following programs:

Adobe Illustrator

Adobe Flash

Adobe Dreamweaver

Adobe InDesign

Adobe Fireworks

The 5th project can be a project of your choosing. These projects do not have to be completed in any specific order.



Learning Tutorials:

With each final project, students must create a learning tutorial to be used to teach others to complete a project as you have done. Now, given the technical difficulties met with some of the programs required, you may create these learning tutorials one of two ways.

<u>Video</u> - Screen recording with voice over.

These finished videos will be uploaded to your youtube channel to be embedded in your online portfolio.

Written - Step by step written instructions.

If you choose to do the written tutorial, you must include screenshots of the project as you go.

Remember, it might be easier to be working on the tutorial as you complete your project instead of waiting until you are completely finished with the project.
